1. Make a map key and symbols to represent items on the map.
2. **Very lightly** using colored pencil draw and label the Great Plains Region green and the Till Plains Region brown.
3. Label the 5 landform regions that are all part of the Great Plains:
The Sandhills, High Plains, Badlands, Wildcat Hills and Pine Ridge.
3. Label the following cities:
Omaha, Lincoln, Grand Island, Kearney, Hastings, Norfolk, Fremont, Beatrice, Nebraska City, Falls City, Broken Bow, Holdrege, McCook, O'Neill, Ainsworth, Burwell, Chadron, Scottsbluff, Sidney, Ogallala, North Platte and Cambridge.
4. Draw and label the following lakes and rivers in blue colored pencil:
Lake McConaughy, Lewis and Clark Lake, Harry Strunk Lake, Johnson Lake, Missouri River, Platte River, Niobrara River, and the Loup Rivers.
5. Draw and label The Oregon Trail route through Nebraska:
