ACT Test Taking Tips

- Spend a few seconds previewing each test before you begin work on it. Check how many pages and questions there are so you can budget your time accordingly.
- Work at a steady pace. You don't need to rush madly through the tests, but you shouldn't dawdle either. Remember, every question is worth the same amount, so rather than getting bogged down on an especially challenging question, move on to the next one – it may be more to your liking.
- Mark up the margins of the test booklet freely – to perform computations, outline reading passages, cross out answers as you can eliminate them, and so on.
- Don't be afraid to guess. You DO NOT get points taken off for wrong answers. Use what you know to eliminate any answer that is clearly wrong, then pick the best answer from among those that remain. Chances are you'll gain points if you follow this method.
- Tackle the questions in order of difficulty, starting with those in a given test that you find the easiest. This will guarantee that you maximize the points you can gain from knocking off the questions you're the best at.
- Fill in the answer sheet carefully. Make sure you don't skip any spaces unintentionally, and don't mark two answers for the same question. Erase all stray pencil marks.
